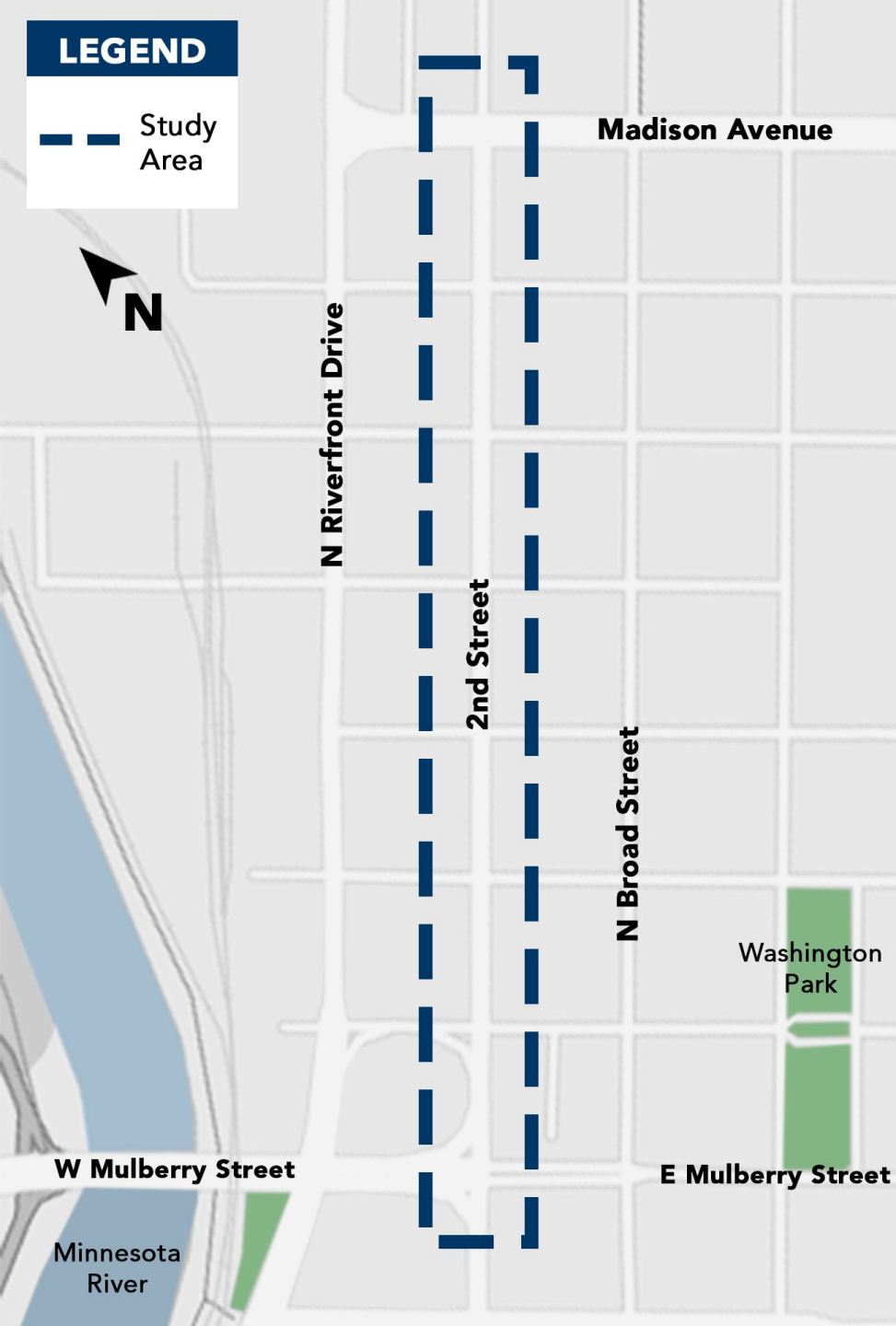

Establish a corridor vision for all ages, abilities, and modes of transportation.



Quantify current and future transportation conditions, issues, and needs.

Develop a fiscally responsible implementation plan that supports the corridor vision.

# Corridor Background



**TRAFFIC:** APPROX. 7,000 TO 10,000 CARS DAILY ALONG THE STREET.



**PARKING:** NEARLY 50 PERCENT OF ON-STREET PARKING UTILIZED DURING THE BUSIEST TIMES.



**SAFETY:** 83 CRASHES IN THE LAST FIVE YEARS, INCLUDING 4 INVOLVING PEOPLE BICYCLING AND TWO WALKING.
